

A By-Law to provide for the election of elected directors in alternate years.

WHEREAS subsection 3 of section 772 of the 'Municipal Act' RSBC. 1960, provides that the Regional Board may by by-law provide that as nearly as possible, one half of the elected directors be elected in alternate years, and in the by-law shall make such provisions as are necessary for the transition from biennial elections.

NOW THEREFORE, the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1) On and from the year 1970, as nearly as possible, one half of the elected directors of the Regional District of Central Okanagan shall be elected in alternate years.

2) For the purpose of giving effect to Section 1 :

(a) the terms of office of the directors for electoral areas A, C, E, G, and F who are to be elected at the annual elections to be held in 1969, shall be from noon on the first Monday after the first day of January following the election, or from the time of swearing in, which ever is the later, until noon on the first Monday after the first day January two years later, or until his successor is sworn in, which ever is the later;

(b) the terms of office of the Directors for Electoral Areas B, D, and H who are to be elected at the annual elections to be held in 1969 shall be from noon on the first Monday after the first day of January following the election, or from the time of swearing in, whichever is the later, until noon of the first Monday after the first day of January one year later, or until his successor is sworn in, which ever is the later.


3) This By-Law may be cited as "Election of Directors By-Law # 6 1969.
