By-Law # 8

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ADVISORY PLANNING COMMISSIONS

WHEREAS Section 798c(1) of the Municipal Act directs that the Regional Board shall establish one or more Advisory Planning Commissions representing the area or areas not included within the boundaries of a City, District, Town or Village Municipality and that the provisions of Division (2) of Part XXI apply mutatis mutandis.

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting, enacts as follows:


1. Commissions to be known as the "Advisory Planning Commissions" of Electoral Areas A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, and I are hereby established.
2. Each Commission shall consist of not less than three nor more than seven members and on the recommendation of the Electoral Director supported by his Advisory Committee to be appointed from time to time by Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Regional District of Central Okanagan.
3. Each member appointed shall hold office for a term co-existent to the term of the Director of the Electoral Area or until his successor is appointed.
4. Upon ceasing to hold office any member shall be eligible for reappointment. Should a vacancy or vacancies occur in the Commissions during the term of office of the Electoral Director, then the Board of Directors, shall by resolution, and on the recommendation of the Electoral Director, appoint a successor or successors who shall hold office under the terms of #3.
5. All members of the Commissions shall serve without remuneration.
6. The Electoral Area Director may be the Chairman of the Commission and shall hold office until his successor is elected or he may appoint the Chairman from the members who shall hold office until his successor is appointed.
7. Each Commission shall adopt its own rules of procedure not inconsistent with these regulations.
8. A quorum is a majority of the members of the Commission.
9. The Chairman, and if he is unavailable, any two members of the Commission may call a meeting of the Commission upon giving at least seven days notice to each member.
10. The Commission shall advise and submit recommendations to the Regional District Director of the Electoral Area in connection with any matter relating to zoning, subdivision of land, planning and building regulations all of which are within the scope of Part XXI of the Municipal Act.
11. All suggestions and recommendations submitted by the Commission shall be duly considered by the Director.
12. This By-Law may be cited at the "Advisory Planning Commissions By-Law # 8".
