BYLAW # 66

Being a Bylaw to Authorize the Borrowing of \$10,000.00, Being the Estimated Cost of Providing Equipment for Mosquito Control

WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan has been granted the authority through the issuance of Letters Patent to provide mosquito control,

AND WHEREAS the maximum amount of the Regional District is authorized to borrow for purposes of the mosquito control function is \$10,000.00,

AND WHEREAS to provide mosquito control within the Regional District it is necessary to purchase equipment, the estimated cost of which is the sum of \$10,000.00, which is the amount of debt intended to be created by this bylaw,

AND WHEREAS the amount of the authorized debenture debt of the Regional District incurred pursuant to Section 786 of the Municipal Act is \$33,750.00 of which \$33,180.00 is existing outstanding debenture debt and \$570.00 is authorized and unissued debenture debt and none of the principal or interest of the debenture debt of the Regional District is in arrears,

AND WHEREAS the amount of the authorized debenture debt of the Regional District incurred pursuant to Section 787 of the Municipal Act is \$1,302,243.00 of which \$1,302,243.00 is existing outstanding debenture debt and NIL is authorized and unissued debenture debt, and none of the principal or interest of the debenture debt of the Regional District is in arrears,


AND WHEREAS the maximum term for which a debenture may be issued to secure the debt created by this bylaw is five years,


NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- (1) The Regional Board is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out and provide mosquito control and to do all things necessary in connection therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing.
  - (i) To borrow on the credit of the Regional District a sum not exceeding \$10,000.00.
  - (ii) To acquire all such real property, equipment, licenses, and authorities as may be required or desirable for or in connection with the provision of mosquito control.


(2) This bylaw may be cited as "The Mosquito Control Loan Authorization Bylaw # 66, 1973.


