

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW #76

Being a Bylaw to Authorize the Submission to the Electors Within Electoral Area A in the Regional District of Central Okanagan on the Question of Participation in the Provision of a Recreation Complex.

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan has been requested to undertake the provision and construction of the arena and curling rink for Electoral Area 'A'.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Kelowna by resolution duly adopted on December 10, 1973, has consented to participate with Electoral Area 'A' in the provision of the said facilities.

WHEREAS the estimated capital cost of the said facilities is approximately \$900,000.00 including land.

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting enacts as follows:

1. That a poll shall be taken of the Electors qualified to vote within Electoral Area 'A' in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Act to determine whether or not the said Electors wish to participate in the provision and construction of an arena and curling rink.
2. That a poll shall be taken on the 30th day of May, 1974, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock in the forenoon and 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon.
3. Advance polls shall be conducted at the office of the Regional District of Central Okanagan, 540 Groves Avenue, Kelowna, British Columbia, between the hours of 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon and 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Tuesday, the 28th day of May, 1974, and those permitted to vote shall sign a statement that they expect to be absent from the area on polling day or they for reasons of conscience are prevented from voting on polling day or through circumstances beyond their control they will not be able to attend the poll on polling day.

- 4. The question on the ballot shall read, "Are you in favour of sharing jointly and in co-operation with the City of Kelowna for the provision and construction of an arena and curling rink at an estimated capital cost of \$900,000.00, including land, and to annually maintain and operate these facilities at a cost which may vary from time to time, and to do all things necessary in connection therewith."
- 5. This bylaw may be cited as "Electoral Area 'A' Recreation Facility Referendum Bylaw #76, 1974."
