

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BY-LAW NO. 131

A by-law to designate certain employees of the Regional District of Central Okanagan as "Municipal Employees" under the "Public Officials and Employees Disclosure Act".

WHEREAS under Section 10 of the "Public Officials and Employees Disclosure Act" being Chapter 73 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1974, provides that the Board of a Regional District, may, by by-law, designate any person employed or appointed by it to be a municipal employee for the purpose of the said Act;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan deems it desirable to designate certain employees of the Regional District as "Municipal Employees" under the "Public Officials and Employees Disclosure Act";

THEREFORE, the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The following persons are hereby designated "Municipal Employees" by the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan pursuant to the "Public Officials and Employees Disclosure Act":
 - (a) A.T. Harrison, Administrator
 - (b) R.V. Haggstrom, Deputy Administrator
 - (c) D.W. Barcham, Director of Planning
 - (d) J.X. Woodroffe, Deputy Director of Planning
 - (e) E. Ashton, Chief Building Inspector
 - (f) A.N. Cushing, Deputy Chief Building Inspector
 - (g) W. Eaton, Regional Parks Superintendent
2. Pursuant to Sub-section (4) of Section 2 of the Act, the written disclosures shall be made and filed by the above-named employees not later than the fifteenth day of the month following the month during which they become a municipal employee.
3. For the purpose of this by-law, the above-named employees shall become municipal employees on the day that this by-law receives final reading by the Regional Board.
4. Pursuant to Sub-section (3) of Section 2 of the Act, the above-named employees shall make and file a written disclosure with the disclosure clerk between the first and fifteenth days of January and of July in every year during which that person a municipal employee.


5. Pursuant to Section 1 of the Act, the "Disclosure Clerk" shall be the Administrator of the Regional District of Central Okanagan.
6. Pursuant to Subsection (2) of Section 4 of the Act, which is subject to Subsections (3) and (4) of Section 4 and subject to Sections 8 and 9 of the Act, no person shall have access to a written disclosure filed by a Municipal Employee.
7. Pursuant to Subsection (4) of Section 4 of the Act, the disclosure clerk shall, upon receipt of a written disclosure filed under Section 3 of the Act by a Municipal Employee, forward a copy of the written disclosure to the Chairman and Directors of the Regional District of Central Okanagan.
8. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Municipal Employees Disclosure By-law No. 131, 1977".






