

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BY-LAW NO. 154

---

Being a by-law to establish an Economic Development Commission

---

WHEREAS by Letters Patent granted the 24th day of February, 1978, authorized the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan to establish, maintain and operate an Industrial Development Commission;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board deems it advisable to establish, maintain and operate an Economic Development Commission;

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That an Economic Development Commission be established with the City of Kelowna, The Corporation of the District of Peachland and Electoral Areas A, G, H, and I as participating member municipalities and to do all things necessary in connection therewith.
2. The annual net cost for the operation and maintenance of the Economic Development Commission shall be apportioned on the basis as set out in the Letters Patent granted the 24th day of February, 1978.
3. The Regional Board shall each year, commencing in 1978 appoint members who are representative of various active groups and business sector of the region to the Economic Development Commission who shall meet from time to time as is deemed necessary by the Commission.
4. The Economic Development Commission shall in each year elect a chairman, vice-chairman and three (3) other Commission members who will form the executive of the Commission and who will be appointed by the Regional Board as the Commission Executive.
5. The Commission Executive shall be the working body of the Commission.


- 6. A Budget shall be prepared annually by the Commission Executive and submitted to the Regional Board for consideration and approval.
- 7. The Regional Board may, from time to time, as deemed necessary appoint an Economic Development Officer and support staff to carry out the policies and instructions of the Commission Executive.
- 8. The organizational structure of the Commission shall be as outlined in 'Exhibit A' attached to this by-law.
- 9. This by-law may be cited as the Regional District of Central Okanagan Economic Development Commission By-law No. 154, 1978.


