

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BY-LAW NO. 240

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ADVISORY PLANNING COMMISSIONS FOR THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

WHEREAS Section 816(1) of the Municipal Act RSBC 1979 requires the Regional Board to establish one or more Advisory Planning Commissions representing the area or areas not included within the boundaries of a City, District, Town or Village Municipality and that the provisions of Division (2) of Part XXI apply mutatis mutandis.

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting, enacts as follows:

1. That Electoral Area Advisory Planning Commissions for Electoral Areas A, G, H and I be hereby established.
2. Each Advisory Planning Commission shall consist of not less than three nor more than seven members and on the recommendation of the Electoral Area Director, members shall be appointed from time to time by Resolution of the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan.
3. Each member appointed shall hold office at the pleasure of the Regional Board.
4. Should a vacancy or vacancies occur in the Commissions, the Regional Board shall by resolution, and on the recommendation of the Electoral Area Director, appoint a successor or successors who shall hold office under the terms set out in clause 3 of this by-law.
5. All members of the Commissions shall serve without remuneration.
6. The Electoral Area Director may be the Chairman of the Commission and shall hold office until his successor is elected or he may appoint the Chairman from the members, who shall hold office until his successor is appointed.
7. Each Commission shall adopt its own rules of procedure not inconsistent with this by-law.
8. A quorum is a majority of the members of the Commission.
9. The Chairman, and if he is unavailable, any two members of the Commission may call a meeting of the Commission upon giving at least seven days notice to each member.
10. The Commission may advise and submit recommendations to the Regional District Director of the Electoral Area in connection with any matter relating to zoning, subdivision of land, planning and building regulations all of which are within the scope of Part XXI of the Municipal Act.
11. All suggestions and recommendations submitted by the Commission shall be duly considered by the Director.
12. That By-law #8, cited as "Advisory Planning Commissions By-law #8" is hereby repealed.
13. This By-law may be cited as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Advisory Planning Commissions By-law No. 240, 1982".
