BY-LAW NO. 244

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Being a By-law to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Septic Tank Effluent and Regulation By-law No. 92, 1975.

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WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan adopted the Regional District of Central Okanagan Septic Tank Effluent and Regulation By-law No. 92, on March 19th, 1975;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board deems it advisable to amend the said by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan enacts as follows:

1. Schedule 'A' of By-law No. 92 cited as "The Regional District of Central Okanagan Septic Tank Effluent and Regulation By-law No. 92, 1975" is hereby amended by deleting said clause 'A' and schedule 'B' attached hereto is substituted therefore.
2. The Regional District of Central Okanagan Septic Tank Effluent and Regulation Amending By-laws #98, 1975, #127, 1977 and #209, 1981 are hereby repealed.
3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "The Regional District of Central Okanagan Septic Tank Effluent and Regulation Amending By-law No. 244, 1983".





SCHEDULE 'B'

BY-LAW

Rates and Charges

1. For each permit issued to a Contractor \$100.00. \$100.00
2. For the annual renewal of each permit issued to a Contractor \$ 10.00
3. For every 1,000 gallons of septic tank effluent disposed of in the works established by the Regional Board pursuant to this By-law 15.75/1,000 gallons
4. Storm and run off water 5.25/1,000 gallons
5. In addition to the fees specified in clause 3 and 4 above, an additional charge of \$26.25 will be made for each 1,000 gallons of effluent disposed of in the septic tank effluent disposal station during the hours that the station is normally closed.
