

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BY-LAW NO. 259

---

A by-law to authorize the submission to the electors within Electoral Area G and the defined area of Electoral Area H on the question of amending the supplementary letters patent for the Garbage Disposal Function.

---

WHEREAS by supplementary Letters Patent dated March 19, 1974, as amended, the Regional District of Central Okanagan was granted the function of Garbage Collection and Disposal under the provisions of Sections 767(5) and 767(6) of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan deems it desirable to provide for the function of Garbage Disposal by way of the assent of the electors of Electoral Areas "G" and "H" under the provisions of Section 767(4) of the Municipal Act so as to remove the limitation as provided for in Section 767(6) of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS the cost of operating this service now will continue to exceed the 2 mill taxation limit operating at the same level of service;

AND WHEREAS the 1983 budget for providing this service was \$166,251. and the 1984 projected cost is \$175,000.;

AND WHEREAS if this by-law is not approved by the electors, the days of service will, by necessity, be reduced to approximately three (3) days per week, particularly for the Westbank Sanitary Landfill;

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. A poll shall be taken of the electors qualified to vote within Electoral Area G and the defined area of Electoral Area H (Code W) under the provisions of the Municipal Act, on an overall basis, to determine whether or not the electors wish to participate in the function of garbage disposal on the terms set out herein.
2. The poll shall be taken on the 19th day of November, 1983 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
3. An advance poll shall be conducted at the Regional District Office, 540 Groves Ave., Kelowna, British Columbia, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on the 10th and 14th days of November, 1983, and those permitted to vote at the advance poll are those who, being qualified to vote, sign a statement that they expect to be absent from the area on polling day, they are for reasons of conscience prevented from voting on polling day, through circumstances beyond their control will not be able to attend the poll on polling day.

4. The question on the ballot shall read:

"Are you in favour of amending supplementary letters patent dated March 19, 1974 as amended to remove the 2 mill limitation and to establish the function of garbage disposal under section 767(4) of the Municipal Act. Thereby maintaining the same or comparable level of garbage disposal service on the westside?"

5. This by-law may be cited as the Westside Garbage Disposal Function Referendum By-law No.259 , 1983.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS 17th DAY OF October , 1983.
