BY-LAW NO. 444


Being a By-law to amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding By-law No. 366, 1988.


WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding By-law No. 366, 1988.

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT Part II - Licensing of Dogs be amended as follows:
 - i) Repeal Section 8 (a) regarding the licensing fee for Farm Dogs.
 - ii) Re-number Sections 8(b) to 8(k) inclusive to 8(a) to 8(j) inclusive.
- 2. THAT Part III - Control of Dogs be amended as follows:
 - i) Amend Section 15 to read as follows:
 'No owner shall tie, secure, or tether any dog except in the backyard and the tethering system shall allow adequate freedom of movement, with a minimum of 3m (10 ft.) radius.'
- 3. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as "The Regional District of Central Okanagan Dog Regulation and Impounding Amendment By-law No. 444, 1990".




