

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW NO. 577

A bylaw to establish a local service to provide for the Management of Solid Waste within the Electoral Areas of 'G', 'H', 'I' and 'A'.

WHEREAS a regional district may, by bylaw, establish and operate a local service under the provisions of Part 24 of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan wishes to establish a local service for the purpose of providing regulation, storage and management of solid waste, including but not limited to, the collection, removal and disposal of refuse and recyclables, within Electoral Areas 'G', 'H', 'I' and 'A'.

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan waives the assent of the electorate in accordance with Part 3, Section 16, Subsection 10 of the Waste Management Act;

AND WHEREAS the Directors of Electoral Areas 'G', 'H', 'I' and 'A' have consented to the establishment of a local service area;


NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan hereby establishes within Electoral Areas 'G', 'H', 'I' and 'A' a local service for the purpose of providing regulation, storage and management of solid waste, including but not limited to, the collection, removal and disposal of refuse and recyclables, and to be known as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Solid Waste Management Local Service Area".
2. The participants in the local service, established under Section 1, are Electoral Areas 'G', 'H', 'I' and 'A'.
3. The boundaries of the service area are the whole of Electoral Areas 'G', 'H', 'I' and 'A'.
4. The annual costs for the service established in Section 1 shall be recovered by:
 - a) The requisition of money under Section 809.1 to be collected by a parcel tax to be imposed in the manner provided by Section 810.1 (2).
 - b) The imposition of fees and other charges that may be fixed by separate bylaw for the purpose of recovering these costs.
5. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually under Section 804(1)(b) for costs of the service shall be \$660,000.
6. This bylaw may be cited as "Regional District of Central Okanagan Solid Waste Management Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 577, 1993".






