

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW NO. 769

A bylaw to convert the function of animal control to an extended service.

WHEREAS under Section 775 (4) of the Municipal Act, a regional district exercising a power to provide a service other than a general service, may adopt a bylaw respecting that service which converts the service to one exercised under the authority of a bylaw establishing the service, and which:

- a) meets the requirements of Section 806 for a bylaw establishing the service, and;
- b) is adopted in accordance with the requirements of Section 813 as if it were a bylaw amending a bylaw establishing a service;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan was granted by way of Supplementary Letters Patent dated the 7th day of April, 1988, the function of animal control for Electoral Areas G, I and Westbank;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan wishes to convert the aforesaid function of animal control to an extended service;

AND WHEREAS consent of has been given, pursuant to Section 807 (2) (a) (ii) of the Municipal Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The function of animal control granted by Supplementary Letters Patent dated the 7th day of April, 1988, is hereby established as the extended service of animal control.
2. The electoral areas participating in the extended service established under Section 1, are Electoral Areas G, I and Westbank.
3. The annual cost for the service established under Section 1 shall be recovered by the requisition of money to be collected by a property value tax to be levied and collected upon land and improvements within the participating areas under Section 825 of the Municipal Act.
4. The cost of providing the service shall be apportioned among the participating areas on the basis of the converted values of land and improvements in those areas;
5. This bylaw may be cited as "The Regional District of Central Okanagan Animal Control Extended Service Establishment Bylaw No. 769, 1998".




Animal Control Extended Service Establishment Bylaw No. 769, 1998


