

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW NO. 775

Being a bylaw to establish a Commission within a portion of Electoral Area 'G' and a portion of Electoral Area Westbank.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 798 of the Municipal Act R.S.B.C. 1979, the Regional Board may establish a Commission under Section 619 of the said Act;

AND WHEREAS the Regional District has established a local service within a portion of Electoral Area 'G' and a portion of Electoral Area - Westbank, to provide recreation services and activities for youth;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to establish a Commission to oversee the development and administration of recreation programming and youth activities;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. There is hereby established a commission to be known as Westside Recreation Commission within a portion of Electoral Area 'G' and a portion of Electoral Area - Westbank which shall consist of nine members who shall be appointed by the Regional Board as follows:
 - (a) One member of Electoral Area 'G' neighborhood associations as recommended by the electoral area director.
 - (b) One member of Electoral Area - Westbank neighborhood associations as recommended by electoral area director.
 - (c) One members from the Electoral Area - Westbank community as recommended by electoral area director.
 - (d) One member from the Electoral Area 'G' community as recommended by electoral area director.
 - (e) One youth member between the ages of eighteen and twenty five years from Electoral Area 'G' as recommended by electoral area director.

- (f) One youth member between the ages of eighteen and twenty five years from Electoral Area - Westbank as recommended by electoral area director.
 - (g) One member representing Westbank First Nations.
 - (h) One member representing School District #23
 - (i) One youth pastor representing westside churches.
2. The commission shall report to and be accountable to the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan.
 3. The term of appointment for the Area Westbank neighborhood associations, the Area 'G' neighborhood associations and the two youth representatives shall each be for a two-year term, except for the first appointments which shall be for one year.
 4. The term of appointment for the members representing Area 'G' community, Area Westbank community, Westbank First Nations, School District # 23 and the youth pastors shall be two years.
 5. All members of the Commission shall serve without remuneration but may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses.
 6. The Regional Board shall in its Annual Budget provide sufficient funds for the reasonable expenses of the commission.
 7. The Commission shall hold its first meeting in January of each year, at which time they shall elect a Chairman and Vice-chairman from amongst the members.
 8. The Regional District Director of Parks and Recreation and/or his/her delegate shall serve the Commission as technical and management advisors and shall have input into the development, and administration of recreation programing and youth activities.
 9. The Commission shall maintain and keep minutes of all its meetings and shall file a copy with the Administrator of the Regional District of Central Okanagan.
 10. The Commission shall oversee the development and administration of recreation programing and youth activities on the westside and shall establish policies necessary for the provision of recreation programing and youth activities through partnerships with the community and community groups.
 11. The Commission shall recommend all contracts, agreements and leases for the provision of recreation programing and youth activities to the Regional Board and said contracts, agreements and leases shall be with the Regional District of Central Okanagan.


12. The Commission in addition to the above shall be responsible for overseeing, monitoring and approving the following:
- (a) Location of youth activity centers,
 - (b) Recreation contracts, agreements and leases
 - (c) Standards for quality and cost effectiveness of recreation programs,
 - (d) Priority of recreation programs and youth activities,
 - (e) Program fees,
 - (f) That all youth have access opportunities to the youth centers and recreation programs,
 - (g) Dispute resolution of user groups,
 - (h) Preparation and submission of annual operational budget to the Regional Board, including any tax subsidy required,
 - (i) Submission of annual reports to the Regional Board respecting the quality, quantity, and location of recreation programs and youth centers.
13. All items of revenue and expenditures relating to the activities of the Commission shall be accounted for in the records of the Regional District of Central Okanagan.
14. No expenditure shall be made which is not provided for in the Annual Budget of the Regional District of Central Okanagan or in the Annual Budget as amended.
15. This bylaw may be cited as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Recreation Program Commission Bylaw No. 775, 1998."


