A bylaw to amend Regional District of Central Okanagan Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 755, 1997.

WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan adopted the Regional District of Central Okanagan Parks Regulations Bylaw No. 755, 1997;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the said bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled, enacts the following amendments to "Regional District of Central Okanagan Parks Regulations Bylaw No. 755, 1997":


1. Add the following definition to Section 3:
 3. n) "Motorboat" shall mean a boat propelled by an internal combustion engine or an electric motor.
2. Add a new subsection 4.(36):
 4. (36) No *person* shall moor a boat in a designated safe harbour at any time other than during storms.
3. Add a new subsection 4.(37):
 4. (37) No *person* shall moor a motorboat in a park or boat launch area other than in designated moorage areas.
4. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Regional District of Central Okanagan Parks Regulations Amendment Bylaw No. 842, 1999".
