

**REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN
BYLAW NO. 1021**

A bylaw to establish a service within a portion of Ellison/Joe Rich Electoral Area to provide fire protection service to the June Springs Area.

WHEREAS a regional district may, by bylaw, establish and operate a service under the provisions of Part 24 of the Local Government Act;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan wishes to establish a service for the purpose of providing fire protection, to a portion of Ellison/Joe Rich Electoral Area;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with Section 797.4 of the Local Government Act, the Regional Board has received a valid petition for the service;

AND WHEREAS the Director of Ellison/Joe Rich Electoral Area has consented to the establishment of the service area;

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Regional District hereby establishes within Ellison/Joe Rich Electoral Area a service for the purpose of providing Fire Protection, and to be known as the "June Springs Fire Protection Service Area".
2. The boundaries of the service area are shown outlined on Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of the Bylaw.
3. The participants in the service, established under Section 1, are portions of Ellison/Joe Rich Electoral Area as shown outlined on Schedule "A".
4. The maximum amount that may be expended for annual costs for the service provided under Section 1 shall not exceed \$1.50 per \$1,000.00 of net taxable value of land and improvements within the service area.
5. The annual costs for the service shall be recovered by requisition of monies to be collected by a property value tax levied on land and improvements for regional hospital purposes, within the service area.
6. The fire protection service established by this bylaw shall carry out all fire protection activities within the service area including but not limited to:
 - a) fire suppression and prevention
 - b) rescue
 - c) medical first response
 - d) disaster planning

- 7. The Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan is hereby authorized to enter into mutual aid agreements respecting the use of equipment and personnel to provide assistance inside or outside of the service area, to the specific clause of circumstances set out in Clause 6 of this bylaw, that may cause harm to persons and property.
- 8. This bylaw may be cited as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan June Springs Fire Protection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1021, 2003".



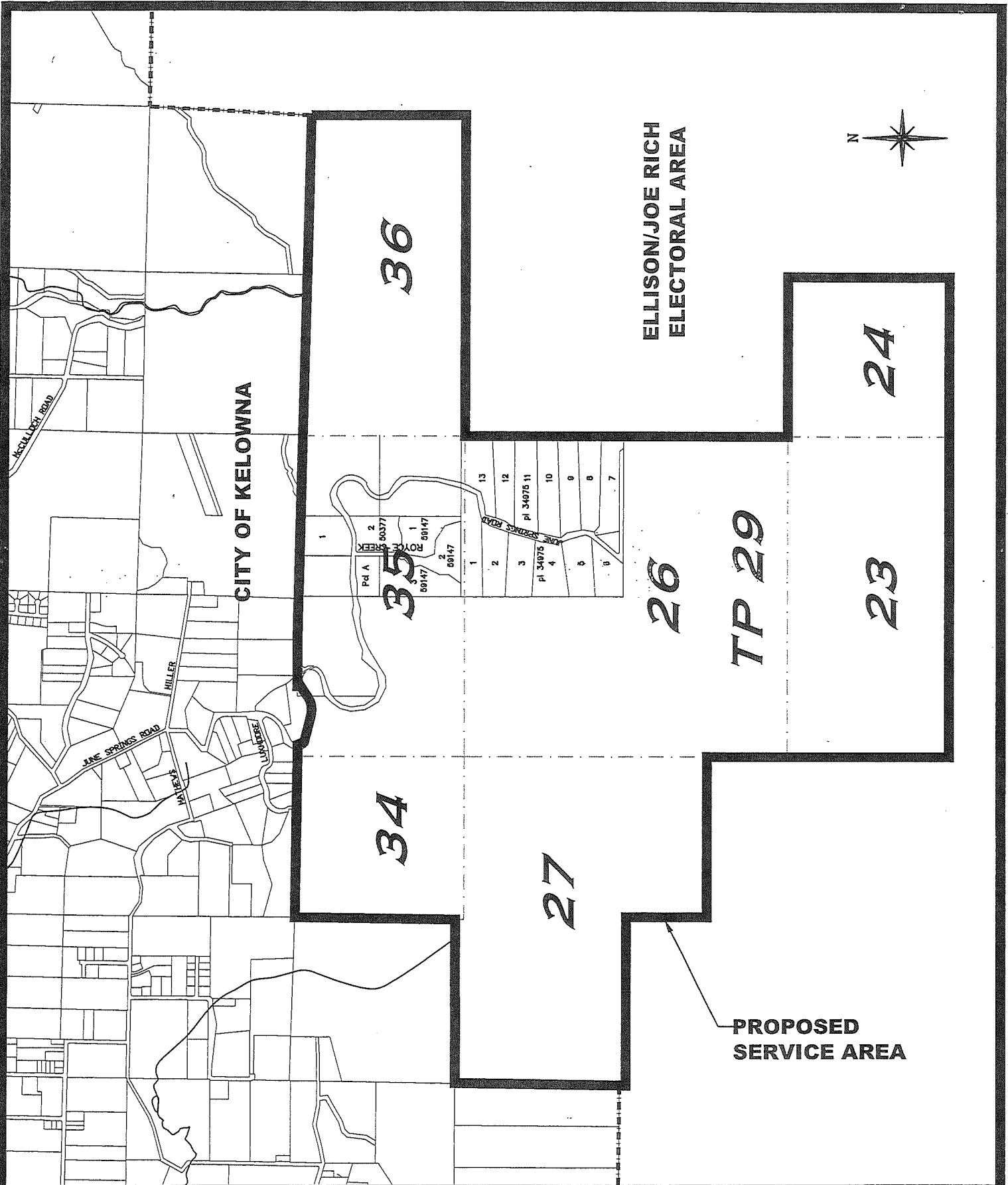

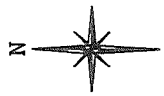
