**BYLAW NO. 1032**

A bylaw to amend Regional District of Central Okanagan Advisory Planning Commissions Bylaw No. 943, 2001.

---

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan is desirous of amending the Regional District of Central Okanagan Advisory Planning Commissions Bylaw No. 943, 2001, under the provisions of the Local Government Act.

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan, in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1 This bylaw may be cited as Regional District of Central Okanagan Advisory Planning Commissions Amendment Bylaw No. 1032, 2003.

2. THAT Section 3. Establishment be deleted and replaced with:

**Establishment**

3. Three (3) Advisory Planning Commissions are hereby established for the following areas as established on Schedule 'A':

Westside Electoral Area North  
Westside Electoral Area South  
Ellison/Joe Rich Electoral Area

3. THAT Section 4. a) and 4. b) be deleted and replaced with:


4. a) All Advisory Planning Commissions shall be comprised of not less than three (3) or more than seven (7) members of which two thirds shall be a resident of the Electoral Area established for the Advisory Planning Commission. A Director of the Regional District, officer or employee is not eligible to be a member of the Advisory Planning Commission, but shall attend meetings of the Commission in a resource capacity.

b) All appointments to an Advisory Planning Commission must be appointed by resolution of the Regional Board on advice of the electoral area directors for said area. Staff recommendations will be submitted to the Board for review and approval. Regional District staff shall advertise in the local paper soliciting for members to said Advisory Planning Commission. Members shall be selected on the basis of their demonstrated interest, regional location, demographic representation, participation in planning issues, community matters, academic or technical qualification, availability, work experience, knowledge and professional expertise.

4. THAT Section 5. a) be amended by deleting the word "may" and replace with "must".

5. THAT Section 5. a) be amended by adding to the last paragraph “, with the exception of the Westside Electoral Area South APC which shall meet at the Regional District facilities.”
6. THAT Section 5. b) be amended by deleting the word “may” and replace with “shall”.
7. THAT Section 5. d) be amended by adding to the last sentence “with the exception of the Westside Electoral Area South APC; a representative from the Regional District shall provide the recording secretary.”
8. THAT Section 5. e) be amended by deleting the words “by the Friday” and replace with “seven (7) days”.
9. THAT Section 5. f) be amended by deleting the word “Friday” and replace with “seven (7) days”.

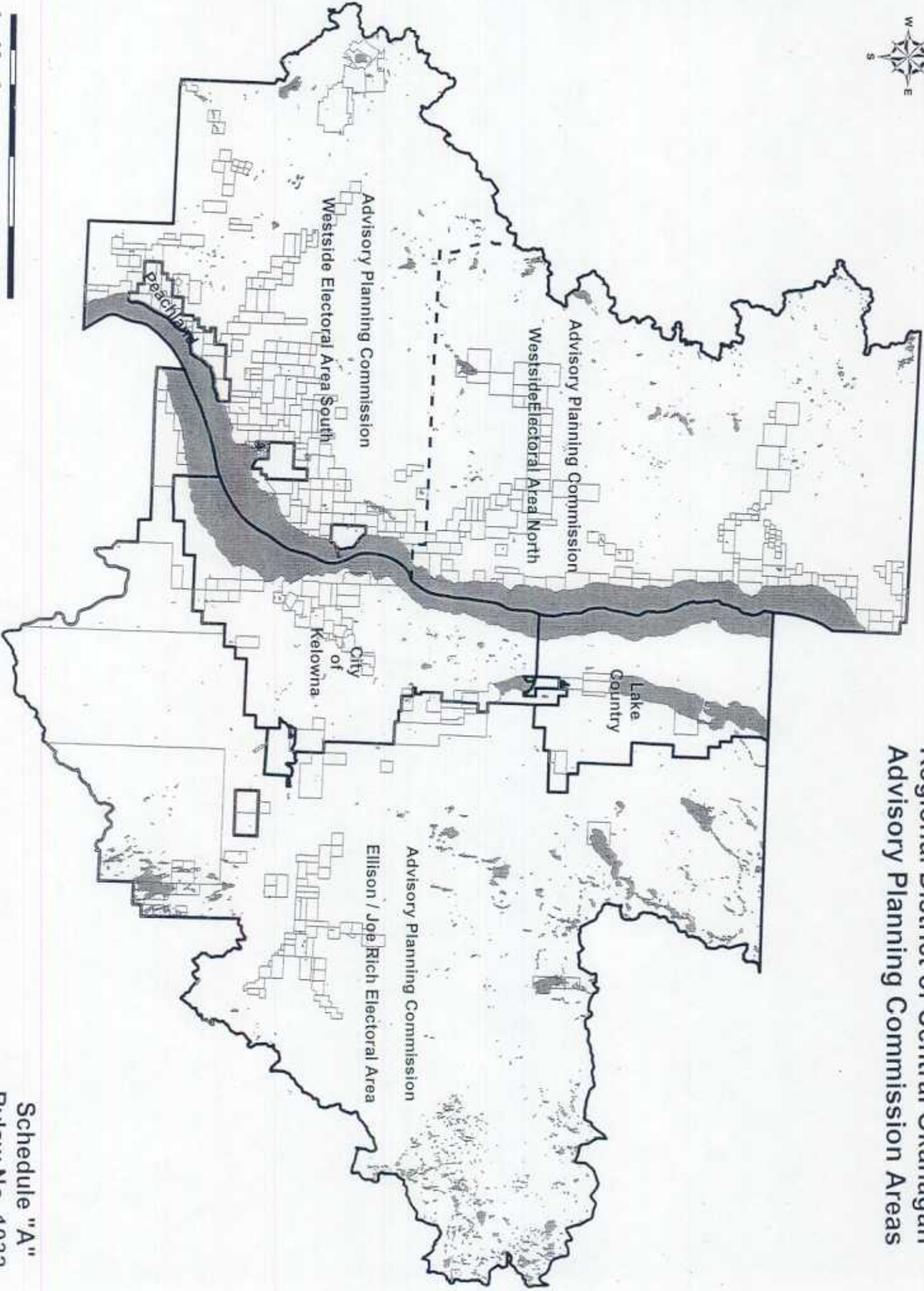
