

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW NO. 1049

A bylaw to convert a street light specified area to a service area.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 774.2 of the Local Government Act, a Regional District exercising a power to provide a continued service, may adopt a Bylaw respecting that service which:

- (a) Converts the service to one exercised under the authority of an establishing bylaw, and
- (b) Amends the power to the extent that it could if the power were exercised under the authority of an establishing bylaw;

AND WHEREAS a regional district may, by bylaw, establish and operate a service under the provisions of Part 24 of the Local Government Act;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan established by Bylaw No. 51, 1971, cited as the "Pritchard Drive Specified Area Establishment Bylaw No. 51, 1971" as amended by Bylaw Nos. 182 and 196, a specified area for the provision of street lighting within a portion of the Westside Electoral Area;

AND WHEREAS the Board of Directors of the Regional District of Central Okanagan wishes to convert the " Pritchard Drive Specified Area" to a Service;

AND WHEREAS the Directors of the Westside Electoral Area have consented to the establishment of the service area;

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The street light specified area created under Bylaw No. 51, 1971, cited as the "Pritchard Drive Specified Area Establishment Bylaw No. 51, 1971" as amended by Bylaw Nos. 182 and 196, is hereby established as a service within the Westside Electoral Area for the purpose of providing street lighting.
2. The participants in the service, established under Section 1, are portions of the Westside Electoral Area.
3. The boundaries of the service area, to be known as the "Pritchard Drive Street Lighting Service Area", are as shown outlined on Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of the Bylaw.
4. The annual costs for the service established in Section 1 shall be recovered by the requisition of money under Section 806 to be collected by a property value tax levied on improvements only imposed in the manner provided by Section 806.1(1)(a).

5. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for the service shall not exceed \$0.0672 per \$1,000.00 of net taxable value of land and improvements within the service area.
6. This bylaw may be cited as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Pritchard Drive Street Lighting Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1049, 2004".


