BYLAW NO. 1269

Being a Bylaw to Amend the Regional District of Central Okanagan Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 435, 1990.

WHEREAS the Regional District of Central Okanagan adopted the Regional District of Central Okanagan Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 435, 1990 and amendments thereto;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional District of Central Okanagan in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. Delete Schedule 1, 2006 (iii) [RDCO Bylaw No. 1174] in its entirety and replace it with new Schedule 1, 2009 (iv), attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
2. Delete Schedule 8, [RDCO Joe Rich Rural Land Use Bylaw No. 902, 2000] in its entirety and replace with a new Schedule 8, 2009 (ii), attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
3. Delete Schedule 10, 2006 (i) [RDCO Solid Waste Management Regulation Bylaw No. 1165, 2006] in its entirety and replace it with a new Schedule 10, 2009 (ii), attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
4. Delete Schedule 11, 2006 [RDCO Business Licensing and Regulations Bylaw] in its entirety and replace it with a new Schedule 11, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
5. Delete Schedule 15, 2005 [RDCO Water Systems Bylaw] in its entirety and replace with a new Schedule 15, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.

This Bylaw may be cited as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Ticket Information and Utilization Amendment Bylaw No. 1269, 2010.
