

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN

BYLAW NO. 1391

Being a bylaw to convert and establish the Regional District of Central Okanagan Crime Stoppers Program Service.

WHEREAS:

- A. By Division XXVIII of Letters Patent issued the 15th day of September, 1988 the Regional District of Central Okanagan (the "Regional District") was granted the function of Crime Stoppers Program Grant-in-aid by the Province of British Columbia;
- B. The Regional District has determined the Crime Stoppers Program should be provided in a manner that most benefits the Regional District, the Central Okanagan Crime Stoppers organization and the general public, whether that be directly through the Regional District, by contract, or by other means;
- C. The Regional District Board has received a request from the Board of Directors of the Central Okanagan Crime Stoppers organization to maintain the ongoing successful relationship with the Regional District in its current format; involving funding, staffing and management support;
- D. Pursuant to section 341 of the *Local Government Act*, a regional district may adopt a bylaw to convert a continued service to one exercised under the authority of an establishing bylaw and may in the same bylaw amend the power to the extent that it could if the power were in fact exercised under the authority of an establishing bylaw;
- E. The Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan wishes to convert the Crime Stoppers Program function for Kelowna, Peachland, Lake Country, West Kelowna and Electoral Areas East and West to a service exercised under the authority of an establishing bylaw;
- F. Approval of the electors in the participating areas has been obtained in accordance with Section 345 [*Approval by alternative approval process*] of the *Local Government Act* and Section 86 [*Alternative approval process*] of the *Community Charter* to approve the change of scope from a Grant-in-Aid to a full service under the authority of the Regional District.

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Service Description

1. The function of providing a Crime Stoppers Program Grant-in-aid as granted by Supplementary Letters Patent dated September 15, 1988 is hereby converted and established to a service to provide funding, staffing and management support for a region-wide Crime Stoppers Program.

Service Area

2. The service area consists of all land within the boundaries of the Regional District of Central Okanagan;

Participating Areas

3. The participating areas for the service are:
- a. City of Kelowna;
 - b. District of Peachland;
 - c. District of Lake Country;
 - d. City of West Kelowna;
 - e. Central Okanagan East Electoral Area; AND
 - f. Central Okanagan West Electoral Area.

Cost Recovery

4. The annual costs for the service may be recovered by one or more of the following:
- a. Property value taxes imposed in accordance with Division 3 [*Requisition and Tax Collection*] of the *Local Government Act*; or
 - b. Revenues received by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant or otherwise.

Cost Apportionment

5. The annual net cost attributable to the service shall be apportioned among the participating areas on the basis of the net taxable values of land and improvements for regional hospital tax purposes.

Requisition Limit

6. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned for the service must not exceed the product of \$0.0135 cents per thousand dollars on the net taxable values of land and improvements in the service area.

Citation

7. The Bylaw may be cited as the "Regional District of Central Okanagan Crime Stoppers Service Conversion and Establishment Bylaw No. 1391, 2016;
