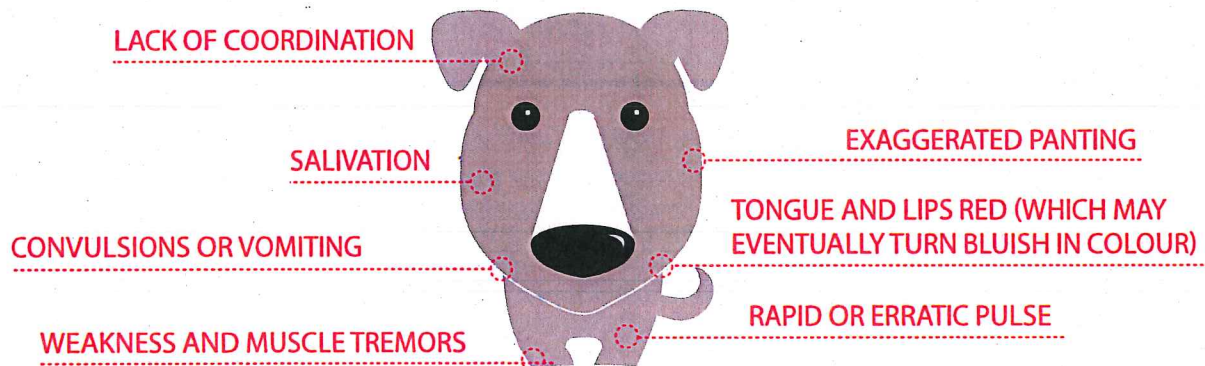


# HOT PETS? NOT COOL!
