The independent review kicked off in July and a final report is expected by late October 2017.

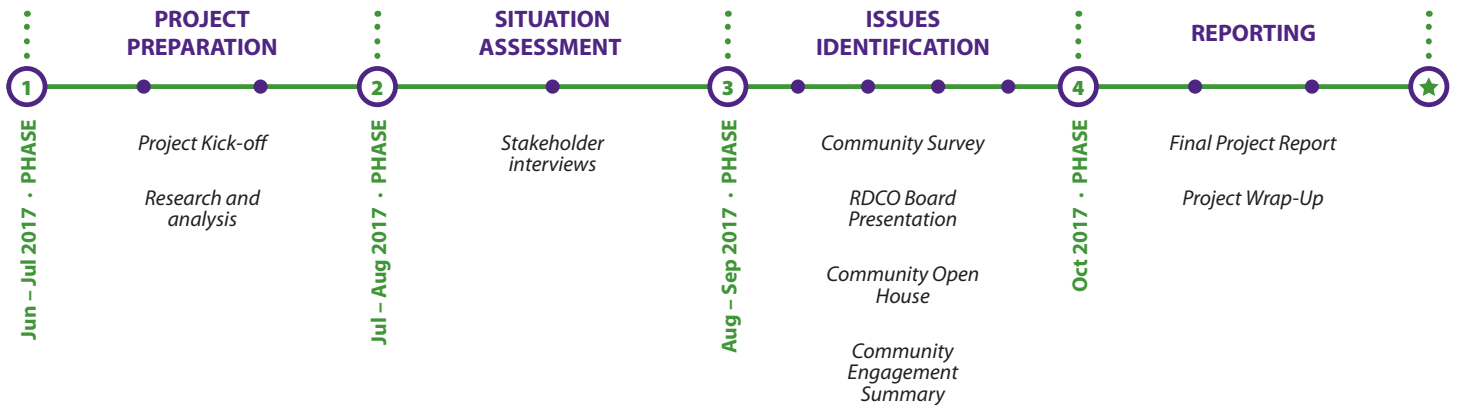
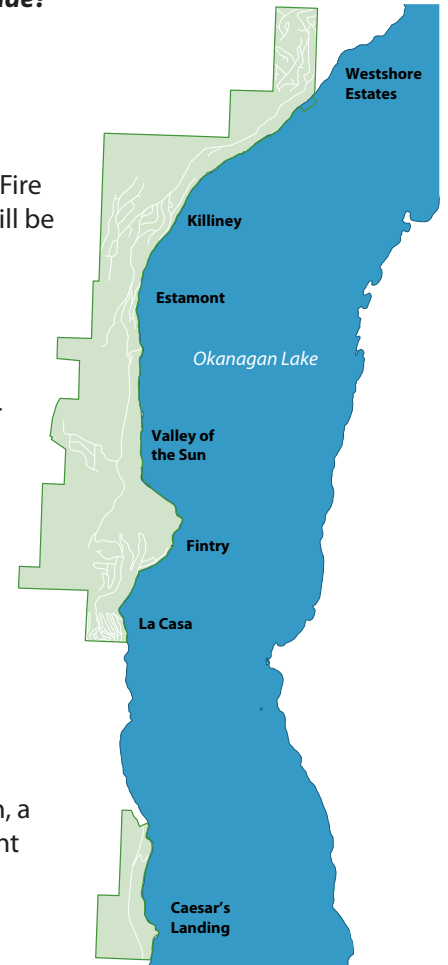
HAVE ISSUES, CONCERNS, OPINIONS?
